Among the great things from this week was WRAD (World Read Aloud Day). This proved to be a great day, one that held some amazing and fun reads and shares with illustrators in a live session. While many of the times didn't work well with our schedule, there are recordings that will be available throughout the next several days.

Next week is another short week. Friday the students are off and teachers are attending professional development, meetings and other sessions. That means with the shortened week a couple items will be adjusted, shortened and removed to keep the workload fair, but cover material adequately.

We have new projects, activities and enrichment getting ready to start. Some of the upcoming highlights (that the class already knows about) are: MinecraftEDu scavenger hunt using X,Y,Z coordinates in multi-biome/multi-realm world. This will have them exploring and searching through a campus themed to be like an ancient Greek campus for learning where Plato might have instructed. The second region is setup like Boston Harbor at the time of the Boston Tea Party. This includes the harbor, many of the actual building and the Old North Church...along with several secret passage ways and more. The final regions of the scavenger hunt are set in the high mountains and involve tricks, teleporting traps and more. We shall see how the student follow directions. Also coming are more robotic platforms. This will include Ozobot, a small but powerful line follower and programmable robot. Last is a new TinkerCad project...Hero Rings. These are loosely themed after the DC Lantern Corp, but extend far earlier into the work of Lee Falk and his multigenerational character, the Phantom. We have a lot of fun coming up soon...buckle up!!
