Reading: Scaredy Squirrel

Focus Skills: Determine how the author uses words and phrases to provide meaning to works of literature, distinguishing literal from nonliteral language, including figurative language (e.g., similes). Ask and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of a text, referring explicitly to the text as the basis for the answers. Retell folktales, fables, and tall tales from diverse cultures; identify the themes in these works. Use terms such as chapter, scene, and stanza to refer to the parts of stories, plays, and poems; describe how each successive part builds on earlier sections. Distinguish personal point of view from that of the narrator or those of the characters. Describe characters in a story (e.g., their traits, motivations, or feelings) and explain how their actions contribute to the plot. Usage – Writing correctly complete simple, compound, and complex declarative, interrogative, imperative, and exclamatory sentences, using coordinating and subordinating conjunctions (e.g., and, for, but, or). Demonstrate command of English grammar and usage.
