


#### For a special snowflake - make one you can eat!

#### **EXPLORE** CAN YOU MAKE FROST?

- Collect a clean, empty can, crushed ice, and salt.
- Fill the can about half way with ice.
- Add a bit of salt and some water.



Watch frost form on the outside of the can. Frost is the water vapour from the air freezing onto the very cold surface of the can.
