The most significant characteristic of the Earth'en home is:

The ~~rance~~ was a long covered hall way of poles and dirt. Usually they were about 40 feet in diameter and 15 feet high.

One of the most important things I learned about the Earth'en home was:

A lot of villages were made of earth. 30 to 50 people lived in each large

The lodge was the main living area for the people. The older women took care of the children in a diffrent part of the lodge. There are three sections; one for the middle aged who cook, one for young women learning their job, and one for the older women who take care of the children.
