The students have been working very hard on their Minetest budget homes. This has been a great project to tie together skills from perimeter, area and square footage. Some students have made great headway in the building and accounting for costs...others have built and still need to count their materials. I have made a calculated risk for this weekend. Most students have chosen to bring home their flash drives and complete work. I have copied their drives on my classroom computer, and that way can ensure I have their data saved up to this point. This does not mean they don't have to return their drive on Monday...THEY DO NEED THEIR DRIVE MONDAY!! The goal is that some students will get their building wrapped up, have their homes to count materials and complete their cost/materials sheet on their Google Drive, and hopefully get work done on their floor plan document.

Along with the Minetest project is also the rocket project. I have tried to assist with several students and collected 20oz bottles appropriate for building a rocket. So far I think everyone has insisted that they are working and researching their rocket. This is also available on the Google Drive...and students are welcome to complete their writing/typing there.

I sent home a flyer (2-sided) yesterday with information about two great events at Purdue Saturday. One is the Boilermaker Regional FLL competition. This will run from about 9am to 3pm at the Armory. FLL is First Lego League. This is the lower level of robotics competition. Westside enjoys all of the First Robotics levels starting with FLL, then FTC, and the large robots in FRC. The second event is a high altitude balloon launch. This will be taking place between 11:30am and 2:30pm on Saturday November 16th in NISWONGER AVIATION TECHNOLOGY BUILDING (NISW) ROOM 149 AND 157. This should be a great opportunity for your child to learn about high altitude balloon projects and research.
