Hello Parents,

What a fast 4 day week...even though I'm exhausted I feel like we accomplished SO MUCH this week. We started reading groups, we reorganized and made great progress in math, many completed more than one of their book projects, and we did it all in FOUR DAYS! Always we seem to enjoy the three day weekend and rush to complete five days' worth of work in four days.

Next week we will continue with reading groups. These are a great guided reading experience where I get to work with students on fluency in reading, pace and meter, and inflection such that they are story tellers...not just boring readers. Next week is the conclusion of the Siege device project. This will be our week for finishing up trebuchets and cannons in class...should be a FUN time!!

I do have a couple items of minor concern. We had trouble this week completing work. Several students did miss one recess break due to incomplete work...but I am in high hopes that this made the correct impression, and that we will not repeat this situation soon. There are a few students that have completed several book projects already!! This is the best news. Five projects are due by Oct. 16<sup>th</sup>. This is part of your child's reading grade. Now, for those that complete five projects and choose to work on more...these extra projects will count as extra credit for your child's reading grade.
